## Camden County August 6 Republican Voter Guide

To vote in the August 6 Primary, you must register to vote by July 10, 2024.

According to the County Clerk's web site, absentee voting is available at their office beginning June 25, 2024.

Early, no excuse voting is available at the County Clerk's office beginning July 23, 2024.

Camden County has already chosen Donald J. Trump as the Republican Presidential Candidate at our March 2<sup>nd</sup> Caucus, so our August 6 Primary ballot will begin with the US Senate race. US Senator Josh Hawley and US Representative for District 4 Mark Alford are running unopposed. They, and other unchallenged Republican candidates will appear on the ballot.

Beginning on page 2, we are sharing the candidates chosen by the Watchdawg Report and our local America First Conservatives. We always recommend everyone do their own research. We are happy to help by sharing the results of our investigations.

**Governor – Bill Eigel** is our clear choice as the America First Candidate. It is unfortunate that the Conservative vote will be split between Bill Eigel and Jay Ashcroft. We expect Kehoe to win the day because of the split Conservative vote, however we wholeheartedly support Senator Eigel and have been energetically campaigning on his behalf.

**Lieutenant Governor – Dave Wasinger** is the America First candidate. We like his assertive approach to “take a hammer to the Jefferson City establishment and career do-nothing politicians.” We have not had the opportunity to meet this candidate. This choice is based on research of the candidates’ writings and input from trusted Conservatives in Missouri.

**Secretary of State – Denny Hoskins** is a long time Conservative Leader. We like him a lot! His very informative website is [dennyhoskins.com](http://dennyhoskins.com).

**State Treasurer – Cody Smith** was very impressive as Chairman of the Budget Committee in the Missouri House of Representatives. He is a staunch fiscal Conservative.

**Attorney General – Andrew Bailey** is our choice. We know Will Scharf is aligned with Trump through Greitens. He would be new to the position. We think Bailey has proven himself by doing excellent work and deserves another term. He is also on record as a strong Trump supporter.

**US Representative District 3 - Bob Onder** is the America First Conservative candidate, as he has proven for years working in the General Assembly. One of our favorites!

**US Representative District 4 – Mark Alford** is unopposed. We are happy to keep him.

**State Representative District 123 – Jeff Verneti** respectfully came forward early to be vetted by our Camden County Republican Central Committee. The incumbent refused vetting. We support the vetted candidate.

**Circuit Judge, Circuit 26 Division 1 – Charlie Dickman** is our choice. Andrew Hardwick was also a strong candidate who we expect to see later when he has gained more years and experience.

**County Commissioner District 1 – James Gohagan** is unopposed.

**County Commissioner District 2 – Daniel Dugan** is our choice based on his professionalism and work experience. We like the fact that he has successfully managed construction projects and has a view of how to improve Road & Bridge processes. We think his experience at managing money and bidding projects applied to the oversight of our taxpayer dollars will be a very good thing.

**Sheriff – Jeff Beachamp** is our choice. He is the only candidate with command experience who is outside the current department. Required changes will take experience and strong leadership. We see visible proof of his capabilities in his current job as Camdenton Police Chief. We could not find any other candidate with matching experience or skill set.

**Assessor – Marty McGuire** is unopposed.

**Treasurer – Kendra Hicks** is unopposed. We would endorse her if she were!

**Public Administrator – Thomas Gorsline** is unopposed.

**Warren Township Committeewoman - Ann Marie Bianchi** is the proven Conservative we endorse for the Republican Central Committee.

**Constitutional Amendment No. 1** – Proposed by the General Assembly

Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to allow places where individuals, corporations, organizations, and associations provide childcare outside of the child's home to be exempt from property tax? This is intended to make childcare more available, which would support the well-being of children, families, the workforce, and society as a whole.

State government entities estimate the state's Blind Pension Fund could have annual lost revenue of up to \$400,000. Local governments expect an unknown fiscal impact.

**We recommend a NO vote.** This amendment reeks of government cronyism. We question why "corporations, organizations and associations" were included in the amendment. Any move to change our State Constitution is suspect. This does not come close to meeting the bar for consideration.

**Constitutional Amendment No. 4** – Proposed by the General Assembly

Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to authorize laws, passed before December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026, that increase minimum funding for a police force established by a state board of police commissioners to ensure such police force has additional resources to serve its communities?

This would authorize a law passed in 2022 increasing required funding by the City of Kansas City for police department requests from 20% of general revenue to 25%, an increase of \$38,743,646 though the City previously provided that level of funding voluntarily. No other state of local government entities estimate costs or savings.

**We recommend a NO vote.** It has always been unclear to the Watchdawg why the state pays for municipal police anywhere. Cities should be responsible for their own municipal police departments. Again, there is a much higher bar than this to amend our State Constitution.

**The Mid-County Fire Protection District Question No. 1** –

Shall Mid-County Fire Protection District, Camden County, Missouri, issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$7,000,000 for the purpose of acquiring real property; constructing, improving, renovating, repairing, furnishing and equipping new and existing fire stations and additions thereto; and acquiring fire trucks, vehicles and other firefighting and emergency apparatus, equipment and communication systems and technology?

**We will leave this one for consideration by only those that live in the Mid-County Fire Protection District.** We hope presenting the ballot language here will give you time to research and make an informed vote.
